
CVCWA's Mission





Suggestions to reduce variability

Implementation into NPDES permits

- More frequent routine monitoring
- Utilizes TST (Pass/Fail)
- Accelerated Testing within testing month

Understand Impacts

• Understand Impacts: Communicate issues with laboratory, testing, scheduling issues, costs, frequency of failed test, etc.
